









AUTISM ACCEPTANCE MATCH AT RED BULL ARENA!


ABOUT THE PATH & HARISON STATION

RED BULL ARENA HOME OF THE NEW YORK RED BULLS


Here's what Red Bull Arena looks like from the outside. This is where you'll be spending your fun day with your friends and family at the AUTISM ACCEPTANCE match!



BEFORE THE MATCH


The Red Bulls have a special outdoor area in front of Red Bull Arena for fun and games called THE BULLEVARD.

The BULLevard will be quiet for the first hour. Also, music in the arena will be lowered.




DURING THE MATCH
